


## Product Orientation and Navigating STAAR MASTER Interactive

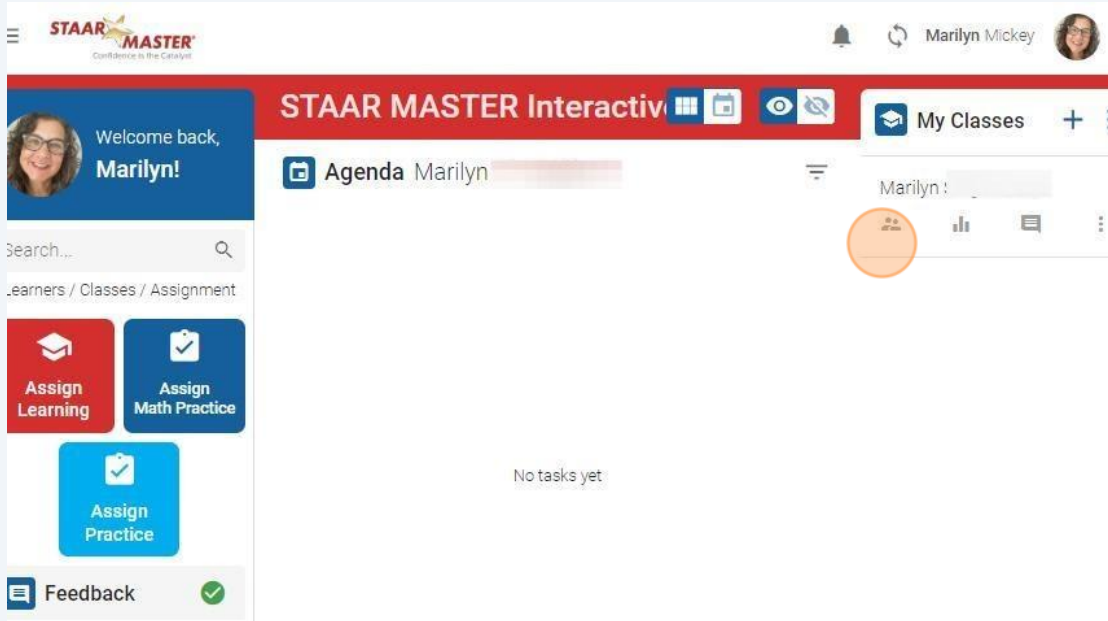

Welcome to STAAR MASTER Interactive! This is your Dashboard where you can locate and create assignments, review student data and provide feedback.

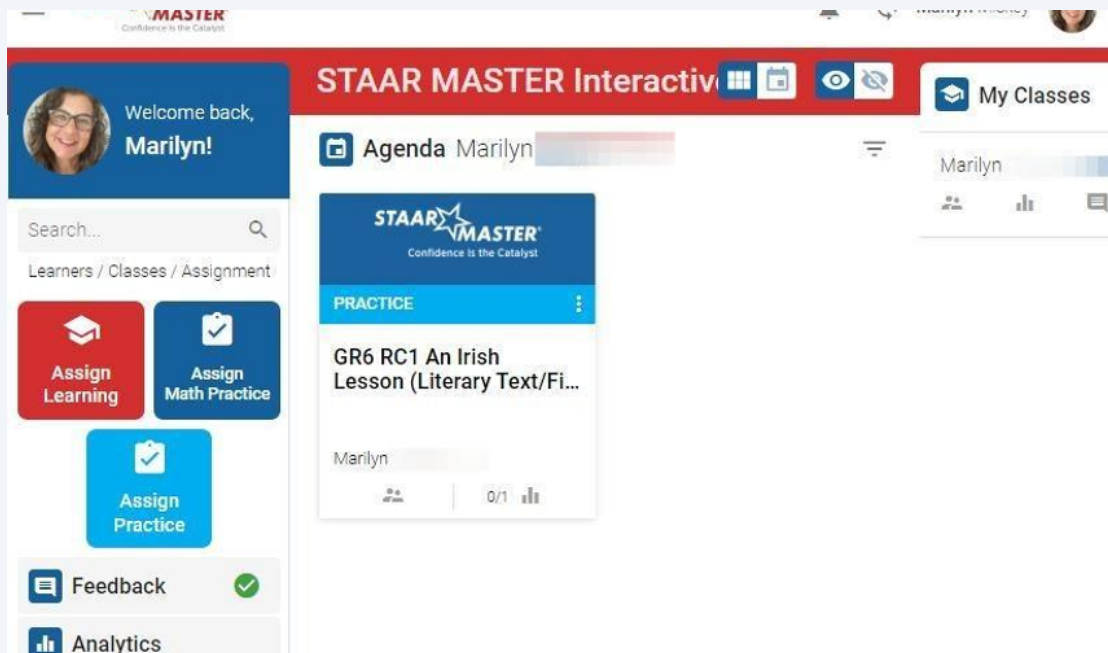

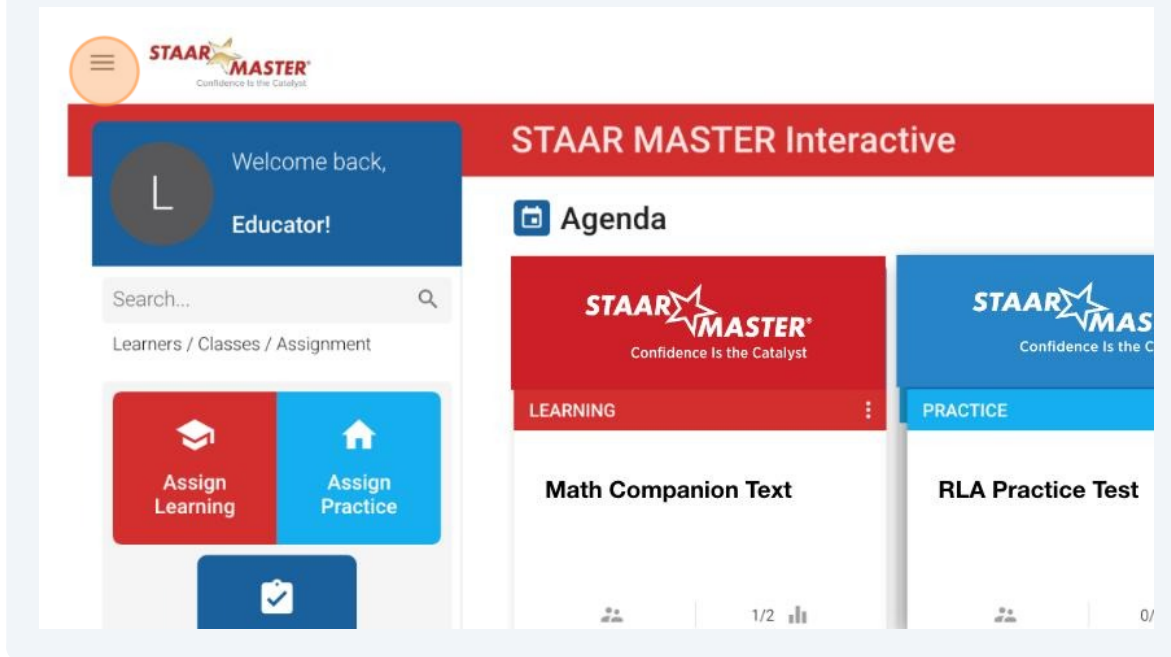

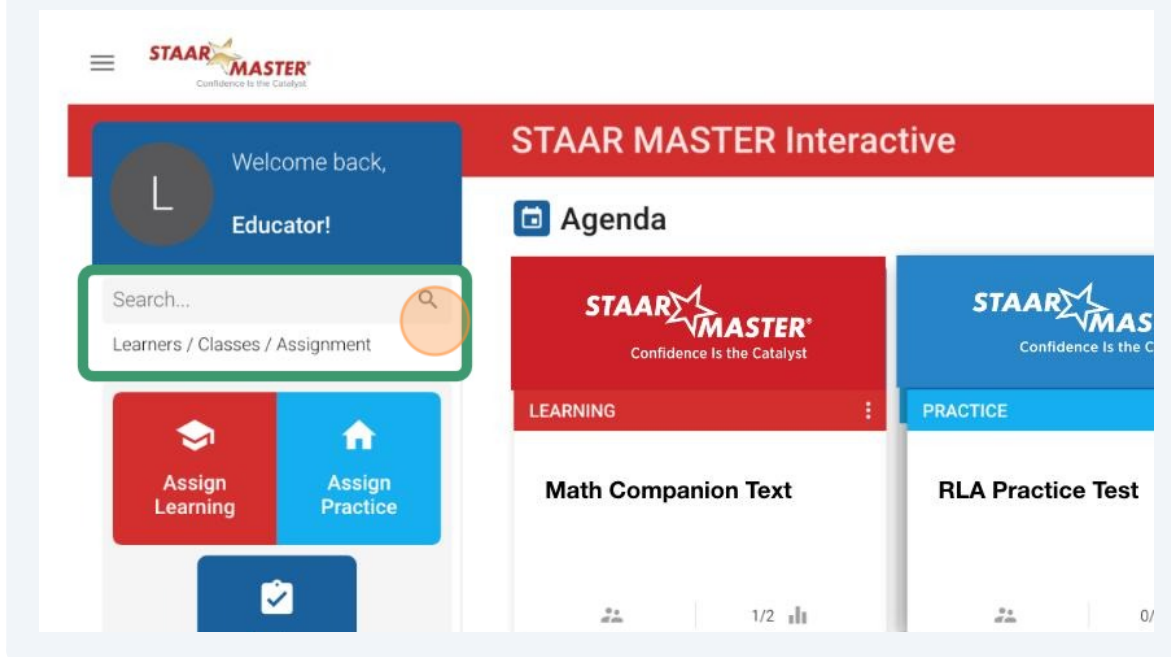
- In the center of your Dashboard are the Assignment Cards you or your team members have created for your students.

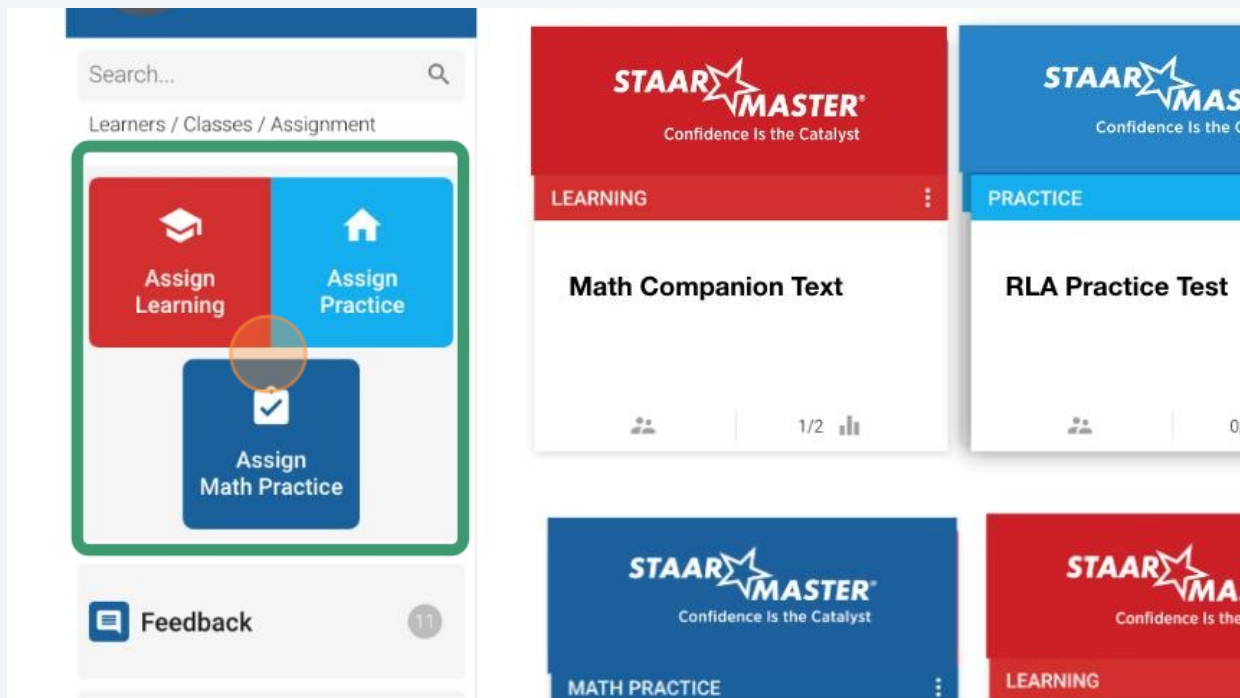
- 5 Under your name is a Search bar to quickly locate learner information, assignments and/or class information.

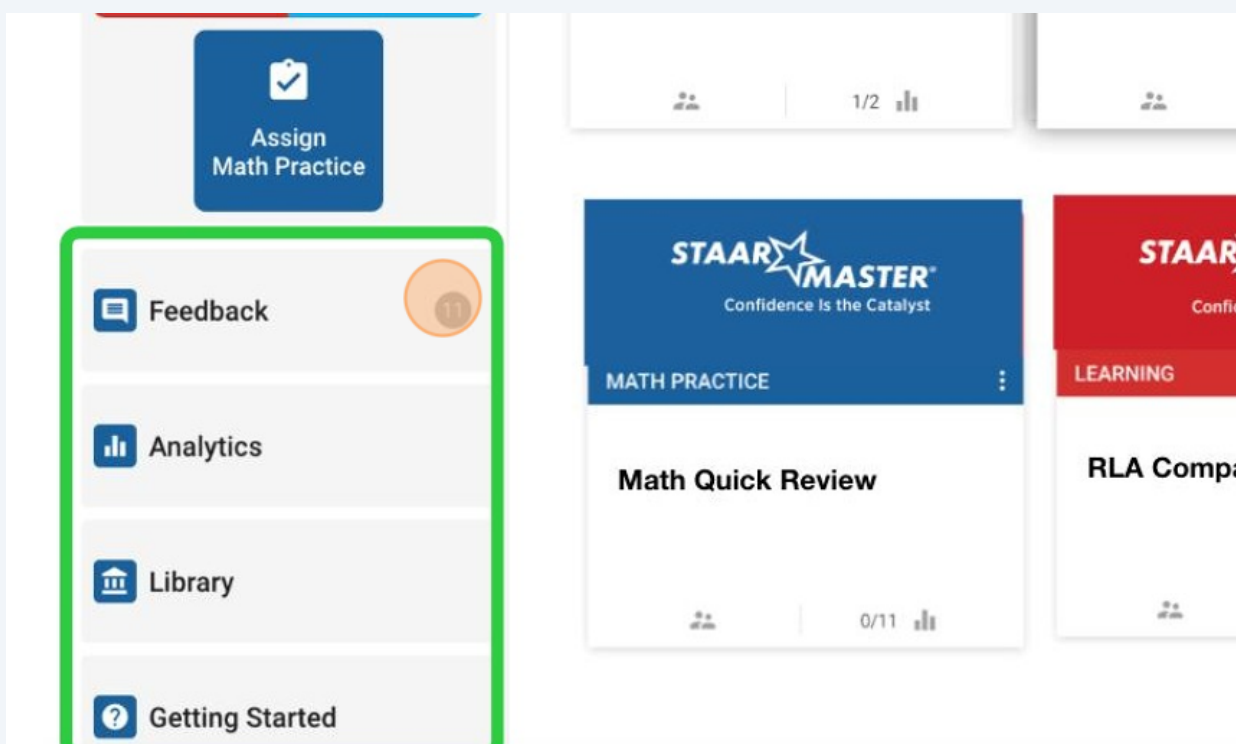
Below the search bar, you will find three content "buttons," taking you to your STAAR MASTER products and create assignments.

- "Assign Learning" - Companion Workbook Texts (RLA & Math)
- "Assign Math Practice" - Practice Books and Practice Tests (Math only)
- "Assign Practice" - Practice Books and Practice Tests (RLA, Science & Social Studies)



7 At the bottom left side of your dashboard are four tiles:

- **Feedback:** A green check mark next to "Feedback" indicates that no students are awaiting review of a constructed response, and a number indicates the number of students waiting for review.
- **Analytics:** This is one way to access student data
- **Library:** This is where you will find Teacher Guides and content. It is also an alternative route to create assignments.
- **Getting Started:** This link will connect you to our website, where you can find User Guides and helpful videos and chat with a live representative.
